

Immigration Policy

- Shared authority between the Federal and Provincial government
- Frequently changing eligibility rules
- Over 65 programs available to employers and foreign nationals to live and work in Canada either as temporary workers or permanently
- Integrating temporary programs is essential for practitioners



Who is your client?

Employer: recruitment and retention

Candidate: assess all permanent and temporary options







Alberta Opportunity Stream

- New program: June 2018
- Job offer required
- Candidates must reside in Alberta, on a valid work permit, working in an eligible occupation
- Most occupations are eligible
- While other provinces have lists of occupations in demand, AINP actually has a list of ineligible occupations.



Alberta Express Entry

Alberta nominates from the federal EE pool.



British Columbia Skills Immigration: SW's

- Job offer required.
- Professional, management, technical, trades, and other skilled occupations



British Columbia Skills Immigration: Health Care Professionals

- Job offer required from a B.C. regional health authority
- Nurses, Physicians, Allied Health professionals



British Columbia Skills Immigration: International Graduates

- Job offer required
- Eligible degree or diploma minimum 1-year from Cdn institution



British Columbia Skills Immigration: International Post-Graduates

- Job offer required
- Masters or Doctoral degree from BC in one of 9 designated fields



British Columbia Skills Immigration: Entry-Levels and Semi-Skilled Workers

- Job offer required
- Tourism/hospitality, long-haul trucking, food processing
- Northeast Development Region of BC: can apply in any NOC (skill level C or D)



British Columbia Express Entry

- Job offer required for SW's Health cares and Int'l graduates but NOT post graduates
- Federal EE profile required + separate BC profile under BC Skills Immigration Registration System (SIRS)
- Northeast Development Region of BC: can apply in any NOC (skill level C or D)



British Columbia PNP Tech Pilot

- 29 eligible tech occupations
- Candidates must qualify under one of BC's streams
- Weekly invitations, accelerated processing



British Columbia PNP Tech Pilot

- 29 eligible tech occupations
- Candidates must qualify under one of BC's streams
- Weekly invitations, accelerated processing



Manitoba Skilled Workers Overseas: Human Capital

- In-demand occupations + strong family connection
- 6-months full-time experience
- No EE profile required
- Minimum 60/100 on grid



Manitoba Skilled Workers Overseas: Express Entry

- In-demand occupations + strong family connection
- 6-months full-time experience
- EE profile required
- Minimum 60/100 on grid



Skilled Workers in Manitoba: Employer Direct Recruitment

 Applicants outside Canada, interviewed by MPNP and ER who receive ITA



Skilled Workers in Manitoba: Manitoba Work Experience

- Applicants currently working in Manitoba on temp WP
- Work Experience:
 - 6 months if demand occupation list
 - 12 months if not on list



Ontario Human Capital Category: EE French-Speaking SW Stream

- EE profile FSW or Canadian Experience Class
- CLB level 7 in French + CLB level 6 in English
- Work Experience:
 - FSW: 12 months during previous 5-years
 - CEC: 12 months during past 3-years



Ontario Human Capital Category: EE Human Capital Priorities Stream

- EE profile FSW or Canadian Experience Class
- Work Experience:
 - FSW: 12 months during previous 5-years
 - CEC: 12 months during past 3-years
- CRS Score: 400's (previously 400)



Ontario Human Capital Category: EE Skilled Trades Stream

- Residing in Ontario on valid WP
- CLB 5 in English or French
- EE profile Canadian Experience Class
- Work Experience:
 - CEC: 12 months during past 2-years
 - NOC 633, 72, 73, 82



Ontario Human Capital Category: Masters Graduate Stream

Closed



Ontario Human Capital Category: PhD Graduate Stream

- International Students with PhD obtained in Ontario
- No language requirements

- IELTS, WES
- Improve Profile: Job Offer; PNP Nomination
- CIC Periodic Draws: Highest Comprehensive Ranking Score
- Successful Applicants will receive an Invitation to Apply (ITA)
- Offer of employment in Canada: A Benefit but not required
- Profile validity: 12-months

Secure Job Offer OR



- Express Entry Provincial Nomination OR
- Selected by CIC without a job offer (Majority Cases)
- CIC Periodic Draws: Highest Comprehensive Ranking Score (CRS)
